The VŠE and the MSD IT Global Innovation Centre have Signed a Cooperation Agreement for the Academic Year 2015/2016

The past year was also significant for the MSD IT Innovation Centre in Prague. In Spring the center moved its headquarters to the brand new Riverview building in Smíchov. Throughout the year, it continued to recruit highly qualified IT specialists, economists, scientists and mathematicians. The company is also planning to continue hiring more people next year. The total investment in the functioning of the Prague center in the period 2014-2016 will reach 1.5 billion CZK. The center focuses on research in information technologies, mathematical modeling, information security, mobile technologies and data analysis.
