

UEP became a member of CIDD

The University of Economics, Prague became a member of the Consortium of International Double Degrees (CIDD) which gathers economic universities offering education in the form of "double degree" programmes.

The UEP joined the CIDD via its "double degree" programme International Business – Central European Business Realities. In this programme, taught exclusively in English, the UEP cooperates with the IAE Lyon 3, France and with the Fachhochschule Mainz, Germany.

To students the programme opens an extraordinary opportunity to study one year in Prague and the other year at any partner university, and to be awarded diplomas from both universities. Currently, in the International Business programme in Prague, 30 students from all over the world in their second year of study are enrolled, while 30 applicants will be admitted into the first year again. The CIDD is a non-governmental association of both public and private accredited economic universities which offer international education in the field of business, and simultaneously broaden their offer with the "double degree" programmes. The UEP became a member of the CIDD in June of this year.

The CIDD's goal is internationalization of practically oriented business education, as well as creation of new opportunities and international experience for students and teachers. At the same time, the CIDD promotes the establishment of close contacts between universities and business sphere, either through sending students to internship programmes or through integrating management representatives into the classes. Thus, the membership of the UEP in the CIDD rep resents another step toward better quality education and internationalization of study.
