Requirements of doctoral study programmes

Doctoral students are required to complete at least four subjects selected in cooperation with their supervisor according to the student's focus and then successfully pass the doctoral state examination held in front of the examination board. Successful passing of this examination is a prerequisite for admission to the defence of the doctoral dissertation. In addition to examinations required by the study plan, an inseparable part of doctoral studies is scientific research and publishing activities, the results of which are regularly presented at department meetings or other similar occasions. Students are also required to complete part of their studies at a foreign institution, to participate in an international creative project, or to directly participate in international cooperation in another form. Full-time students also participate in teaching and support activities, such as the preparation of reviewer's report on final theses of students in pre-doctoral study programmes.
